There are a few things that your child will need to help us get off to a good start. Please bring supplies to Open House.

*** Please label all items***

- 2 boxes of 24 count Crayola crayons
- 1 red plastic 3 prong/pocket folder
- 3 folders with pockets & 3 prongs – label with child’s name (*colors: blue, orange, purple – 1 of each*)
- Book bag large enough to fit a lunchbox and folder – label with child’s name (no wheels please)
- 1 ½ inch 3 ring binder with clear plastic sleeve on the front
- Fiskar scissors – label with child’s name
- Pencil box large enough to fit all “tools” and easy for child to open
- Watercolor paints with brush (8 colors)
- Crayola Broad Line Markers – Classic – 10 count
- Pack of 3 large Elmer’s glue sticks
- 1 box of gallon sized Ziplock bags
- 1 bottle of foaming hand soap
