H.E.A.R. – Luke 1 By Rev. Scott Hearn

Highlight - Luke 1: 1 - 4

1 Many have undertaken to draw up an account of the things that have been fulfilled among us, 2 just as they were handed down to us by those who from the first were eyewitnesses and servants of the word. 3 With this in mind, since I myself have carefully investigated everything from the beginning, I too decided to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, 4 so that you may know the certainty of the things you have been taught.

Explain – Luke is making his intent for writing his book very clear, to draw up an **account** of the things that have been fulfilled among us, referring to the life of Jesus. This isn't how legends or fairytales begin. What Luke will present to us is the result of careful investigation. Why? So we may know the certainty of the things we have been taught.

Apply – What if I read the Book of Luke as if it were a carefully investigated orderly account of the life of Christ? What if there really was a man named Jesus who walked on the earth at a specific location at an exact time in history. What if He really did teach, hear, perform miracles, and cast out demons? What if He really did die on a cross and what if He really did come back to life three days later?

Respond – Jesus, as I read through Luke, I want to come face to face with the real You. I want to experience You the way those did who were in Your presence 2000 years ago. And like them, I want my life to be transformed. Let me meet with encounter the Living God and let my life never be the same. Amen.
